Presently, we can be found in greater Washington D.C., San Francisco, Denver, Baltimore and Portland.

We're currently looking to fill 4 Asst Director of Instruction roles in CA:

JOB SUMMARY

The Assistant Director of Instruction has a specific focus on youth and adult indoor programming. Overall management and mentorship of Team Members during shifts and general operations of the climbing gym is required. The Assistant Director will serve as a manager for the climbing gym as part of a rotating management schedule shared between the leadership team. As with all managers, they are expected to embody El Cap's mission and core values, leading by example for their staff.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist the Director and co-Assistant Directors with the management of all gym operations and administrative duties including but not limited to:
 - Hiring, training, scheduling, management and mentorship of a cohesive team who collectively embody El Cap's core values (Innovation, Passion, Partnership, Integrity, Inclusion)
 - Overseeing the delivery of excellent instructional, programming, and front-line customer service
 - Coordinate with the Regional Assistant Director (RAD) of Programs and lead training and mentorship of instructional Team Member (from gateway programs, to youth team, and adult programming)
 - This includes teaching or auditing classes to model best practices and support staff development.
 - Collaborating with key players from the gateway programs, youth teams, and adult programming to support and create continuity in the life of a climber and our community.
 - Managing their location's program/class calendar with the goal of expanding class enrollment and accessibility of our programming to our customer base.
 - This includes assessing which programs to offer and when to best meet the needs of that facilities community.
- Additional duties as assigned

- Serve as a manager on duty for the climbing center as part of a rotating management schedule.
- In partnership with the gym and regional Director teams help build curriculum and programming as well as develop training for instructors with the goal of offering the most progressive climbing instruction in the industry.
